



Please Read: How to Prepare and Ship/Drop-off Goggles

The procedure for preparing goggles for shipment is the same whether you are shipping them yourself or dropping them in a collection bin.

Remember to ALWAYS practice recommended social distancing!

What you will need:

- Disinfecting wipes or spray (such as Lysol or equivalent)
- Clean rags
- Clean, unused ziplock bags (if possible, use a separate bag for each pair of goggles)

If self-shipping:

- Clean, sturdy cardboard box
- Shipping tape
- Address of facility to which you are donating goggles

Prepare the goggles:

1. Gather all your materials.
2. Wash your hands thoroughly for 20+ seconds.
3. Using your disinfecting wipes or spray and a clean rag, thoroughly clean your goggle preparation work area.
4. Using your disinfecting wipes or spray and a clean rag, carefully wipe down/clean ALL parts of the goggles being donated and let dry.
5. Once the goggles are dry, place each pair of goggles into a clean, unused ziplock bag and seal the bag.

Ship/Drop-off the goggles:

1. If you are self-shipping your goggles:
 - a. Place the ziplock bag or bags of goggles into the cardboard box and seal the box closed with tape.

- b. CLEARLY write the facility address on the box.
 - c. Either arrange online for a UPS/FedEx pick-up from your home or, *while practicing safe social distancing*, ship box from your local shipping location.
2. If you are dropping goggles at a collection site:
- a. Remember to practice safe, social distancing!
 - b. If possible, drop goggles directly into collection bin without touching it.
 - c. If you must touch the collection bin, immediately sanitize or wash your hands!

Be assured, the collection point person will wear gloves and wash their hands when handling your donation.
